Applications are invited (in prescribed proforma) from eligible Advocates for appointment/engagement of one Special Public Prosecutor for conducting trial in the cases of CBI pending in the Courts in Dhanbad.

Fee Structure in respect of CBI Special Public Prosecutors

Professional fee of the Advocates appointed/engaged as Special Public Prosecutor will be governed by the terms and conditions contained in DoPT letter No.225/19/2023-AVD-II dated 08.04.2024 (copy enclosed).

Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility criteria for applying for the post of Special Counsel for CBI are as under:

1. Educational Qualification: LLB
2. Enrolment Certificate as an Advocate with the Bar Council.
3. Experience at Bar in handling criminal cases.
4. An unconditional willingness/consent to work on the general terms and conditions approved by the Government of India from time to time.
5. Details of important cases handled by the applicant Advocate.
6. A minimum standing of 10 years or more as an Advocate having experience in handling criminal matters.

Period of Engagement: Minimum 03 years.

Nature of Job

To conduct trial in the cases of CBI, Dhanbad in the Trial Courts of Dhanbad.


Documents to be submitted along with the application

1. Educational Qualification.
2. Enrolment Certificate as an Advocate with the Bar Council.
3. Experience at Bar for 10 years or more as an Advocate having experience in handling criminal matters.
4. An unconditional willingness/consent to work on the general terms and conditions approved by the Government of India from time to time.
5. Details of important cases handled by the applicant Advocate.

The complete application in prescribed proforma along with the requisite documents should be submitted online through the given link. The documents will be uploaded by the applicant through the link. In case of incomplete application and application received offline and after the last date, application shall not be considered. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for interaction by CBI.

Out of Headquarters	<p>If the Counsel is required to go out of Headquarters in connection with conducting the CBI cases e.g. for appearance in court outside the Headquarters, he will be entitled to a daily fee of Rs. 1000/- per day for the days of his absence from the Headquarters including the days of the departure from, intervening holidays and arrival back at the Headquarters.</p> <p>Provided that no fee will be paid for the day of departure if he leaves the Headquarters after court hours or for the day of arrival if he arrives at the Headquarters before the court hours.</p>

2.	Travel/Hotel Expenses	In addition to the daily fee, the counsel will also be entitled to travel expenses for travel by air (economy class)/AC-II tier or first class by train, road mileage for the journey from his headquarters to the airport/railway station and vice-versa and from the airport/railway station to the place of his stay out of Headquarters and vice-versa at the rates admissible to the Group A Gazette Officer of the Central Government, he will also be paid conveyance charges for performing local journey while outside the Headquarters at the rates as admissible to the Group A Gazetted Officer subject to a maximum of Rs.338/- per day, he will also be entitled to a reasonable actual expense for stay in Hotel at the rates as admissible to the Group A Gazetted Officer subject to a maximum of Rs.2250/- per day in terms of instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance from time to time.
3.	Clerkage	The Counsel will be entitled to 10% of fees subject to a maximum of Rs. 1800/- in a case or batch of cases by way of Clerkage.
4.	Out of Pocket Expenses	The amount required for court fees at the time of filing a case; and other miscellaneous expenses not exceeding Rs. 750/- should be obtained by the counsel in advance from the concerned branch/unit of CBI on whose behalf the Counsel will conduct the cases in the trial court. An account of the expenses incurred should be rendered to the concerned branch/Unit while presenting the final fee bill.
